2006 CAAA & Tina Wu Scholarship Program

Sponsor: Chinese American Abacus Association

Purpose: To expand and enhance students' interests and understanding in Chinese abacus culture and reward students with outstanding performance in the subject.

Rewarding System: 18 students will be rewarded

\$ 50 for grade students

\$100 for advanced students

Eligibility:

- I. Students have attended the Abacus & Mental Arithmetic Assessment Test for three consecutive years.
- II. Students have been recommended by a teacher of CAAA.
- III. Students have met both conditions listed above.
- IV. If the applicant has received a scholarship before, he/she cannot apply for a scholarship for that item again.

Requirements:

- I. Students have passed the Abacus & Mental Arithmetic Test with grade level 2 or higher.
- II. As an elementary school student, he/she had met grade 3 mathematics.
As either a middle or high school student, he/she had obtained a grade of B or higher in his/her mathematics courses.
- III. Students submit a one-page essay that discusses his/her mental arithmetic learning experiences or why he/she decided to learn abacus.
- IV. Students qualify the three requirements above.

How to Apply:

- I. Fill out an application form legibly and be sure to only apply for either the mental arithmetic or abacus scholarship, not both at once. Applications that are not completed correctly will not be processed.
- II. Submit your one-page essay along with your application form.

Application forms will be accepted starting April 10th, 2006.

No application forms will be accepted after May 1st, 2006.
