



2015 World City Cup

Abacus, Mental Arithmetic, & Math Competition



In conjunction with the World City Cup, the Chinese American Abacus Association will be holding two competitions, a **Drawing Contest** and a **Writing Contest**, for students of CAAA teachers.

Students will be able to participate in one or both contests. Three (3) winners will be chosen for each contest. The winners will be awarded free admission to the 2015 World City Cup aboard the USS Hornet, and will be presented with a certificate during the World City Cup Awards Ceremony.

The deadline for both contests will be **Tuesday, January 20, 2015**.

The **Drawing Contest** will consist of one drawing, in any form, to be presented on paper no smaller than letter size (8.5" x 11") and no larger than tabloid size (11" x 17") about any topic related to abacus, preferably with an international theme in conjunction with the World City Cup. Entries for the drawing contest may be used in promotional material for the event, including but not limited to flyers, the event book, the event t-shirt, and on the CAAA website.

The **Writing Contest** will consist of one piece, in any form, that best answers one (1) of four given prompts in 500 words or less. Entrants shall register and submit their work through the CAAA website at caaa-abacus.weebly.com. Entries for the writing contest may be reprinted in the event book and on the CAAA website.
